Hazel was introduced to the sport of bowling in the fall of 1942, by her father, at the Salina Recreation Hall. In 1943 Hazel bowled on a team as a sub and joined the team as their regular member. She started bowling in 1945 with her mother, the following year in 1946 Hazel bowled in her first state tournament which was held in Hutchinson.

Hazel also was selected as Kansas WBA Historian and served in that capacity for twenty-one years. Creating the KWBA History Albums, these books required many hours of labor, great patience and the ability to choose what might be of the most importance to the future members of Kansas WBA. In 1961 she and our president, Bonnie Hodgson, acted as recorders for a special meeting of the WWBA with WIBC President, Mrs. Alberta Crowe and WIBC Secretary, Mrs. Emma Phaler. She has participated on panels for Jamborees in Wichita, Hutchinson and Great Bend, and served as State Representative for eight years. In 1963 signed the original Articles of Incorporation of KWBA as its Second Vice President.

Hazel was responsible for the production of the many pages, placing each in its proper category, indexing them, and inserting them in the binder with the name of each officer and /or director on the outside. This was a tremendous task, and the result of her labors is the Policy and Procedure Manual in use for the Kansas WBA Board of Directors.
