# 2026 KANSAS STATE USBC-SENIOR TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) The senior tournament is open to all Kansas State USBC certified bowlers who have reached their 50<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before the opening date of the tournament. Bowlers need not be a member of a senior league. A USBC member who is a non-resident of Kansas may participate in the tournament by paying the additional Kansas State USBC and local association dues of the hosting city **prior** to tournament participation.
- 2) The events are doubles and singles with **optional** all events and **optional** 4-member team event.

DIV. 1- 140 YEARS & OVER  
DIV. 2- 130-139 INCLUSIVE  
DIV. 3- 120-129 INCLUSIVE

**SINGLES & ALL EVENTS**

**TEAM EVENT IS ALL ONE CLASS**

- 3) **MULTIPLE TEAM ENTRY** – All bowlers may bowl the team event twice. You must change 2 bowlers to bowl a second time. The second team entry must be submitted on separate entry form before entries close.
- 4) **MULTIPLE DOUBLES/SINGLES ENTRY** – Entrants must change partners for the second event. Entrants in the doubles events must enter the singles event and vice-versa including multiple entries. The **first bowled doubles and singles event** counts for the All-Events score. The second doubles and singles scores do **not** count in the All-Events total.
- 5) The entry fee will be \$30.00 per event (prize fund \$12.00, expenses \$18.00 and include lineage, national entry, and shirts.) Entry fees must accompany entry form. **All Events entry fee will be \$6.00 per bowler (\$4.00 prize fund, \$2.00 expense).** **Make all remittances to: Kansas State USBC.** A \$30.00 fee will be assessed on any returned checks.
- 6) The entering average will be: **a)** the highest USBC certified league average as a regular or substitute based on bowl.com as of the end of the 2025-2026 season, providing they have bowled 21 or more; **b)** If no (a), then a current league average of at least 12 games as of the opening date of the tournament will be accepted. Please provide a copy of the league sheet to the Tournament Director for verification; or **c)** if no (a) or (b), will be entered with an assigned average of 220 for the Women’s Tournament and 220 for the Open Tournament. Each bowler must use the same hand in bowling all games in the Kansas State USBC Open Tournament. Refer to USBC rule 319a.
- 7) Competition will be on a handicap basis using 90% of the difference in the entering average and 220.
- 8) All events will be determined by the addition of the doubles and singles scores (with handicap) only. All prize fees will be returned 100%. Team scores will not count towards all events.
- 9) The paid All Events winner in each division will have their entry paid into the national senior tournament. In the event of first place ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. To break the tie to determine who goes to nationals, the highest singles game score with handicap will be used. In the event a tie still exists, the second highest game score with handicap will be used. National average used is the highest average reported to USBC.
- 10) It will be the bowler’s responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average and division. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than correct average. Prize winners will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. Winners will be verified.
- 11) Average correction can be made up to the end of the first game of a series. If an extension of time has been granted in writing by tournament management before the end of the first game of a series, the correction can be made within 48 hours after the end of the series.
- 12) Please be up and ready to bowl when the pins are set for your turn on the lane. Keep the fun going so the squad finishes on time. Tardy bowlers will receive 0 for each frame missed but may enter competition when it is their turn, and they are ready to bowl.
- 13) All other matters will be governed by USBC Rules.
- 14) **The deadline for entering will be October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026.**

**ADDITIONAL NOTES:**

- **Entry fees will not be refunded**
- Confirmation will be mailed w/dates & times
- USBC membership cards must be presented
- **An additional weekend may be added, if necessary**
